

## CONSIGNMENT

In early April I learned that in less than a month I had sold five books on consignment at Grounds for Celebration in Beaverdale! I know visibility is a big factor, and I'm grateful to them.



Consignment can be helpful for people to see books, especially independently published ones. If you ever want to know if an author's books are in a store, merely ask. If you would like to see them at that location, merely notify a manager or the checkout desk. Even large bookstores like Barnes and Noble and Books-a-Million (BAM) respond to numerous requests. They DO want to sell books, even if they don't automatically carry them in stock! Also, don't be hesitant to speak with a manager of a store that relates to your genre or to the topic of your book. Coffee shops are beginning to carry more books, some gift shops...You may just have to get on the phone, send some emails, but the best results are still achieved by personal visits. Then, you may want to see if the store will do a "Meet the Author" or a book signing for you!
